THE EPIPHANY OF THE LORD

The Feast of Epiphany originated from the Eastern Church which celebrates the manifestation of Christ as the Son of God. Customarily observed on January 6, the twelfth day after Christmas, however, in other regions of the world, this feast has been shifted to the Sunday between January 2 and January 8. Epiphany represents the spread of Christ's kingdom to the entire world, Christ's revelation to all of the Gentile world, symbolised by His revelation to the three kings at Bethlehem. This feast shows us that all nations, not just a select few, are called to Christianity. The world was dark during Advent, and we prayed and waited in the spirit of the Jewish people, who had been waiting for the Coming Light for thousands of years. Mary, Joseph, and the shepherds were the only people around the cradle who could see the dimly shining light at Christmas. However, the prophesy that states, "The Gentiles shall walk in Thy light, and kings in the brightness of Thy rising," (Isaiah 60:3) is realised during Epiphany when the Light shines forth to all nations. Epiphany requires us to bringing the light of Christ to everyone we encounter, just like these kings did. In the gloom of our own world, it is our duty to shine that light. It is obvious how important the feast of Epiphany must be to all of us who are working to spread Christ's kingdom.
